

Here is a summary of major action taken at the June 20th Special Called Executive Committee meeting. Please share this information with your region and constituents. The complete minutes will be posted on the VHSL website later and will include a more extensive account of the meeting, including specific language for legislative proposals for the benefit of the membership and readers.

ACTIONS:

- Approved for a two-year period, that the state tournament rotation policy be A vs. B and C vs. D.
- Approved for regions to cross-bracket in the jubilees, and in jubilee-like events, beginning with the 2018-19 school year.
- Approved the state playoff formats presented with the exception of basketball and approved the following: Beginning with the 2017-18 school year for state basketball, the quarterfinals and semifinals be played in the higher seed's area. Regions are to pre-determine North, South, East and West locations.
- Approved the elimination of the policy in in regard to motel reimbursements: PM (Policy Manual) 55-5-1 (3) Housing Expenses – The motel expense reimbursement shall be limited to the “official team party” of players, managers, certified athletic trainer (ATC), bus driver....For purposes of reimbursement, the number of authorized motel rooms is shown below. ~~If a school does not stay overnight but the formula permits schools to do so, the VHSL will reimburse one half the value of the unused rooms, if requested.~~
- Approved for staff to develop a mileage chart for travel reimbursement and bring back to the September Executive Committee for approval.
- Directed staff to develop a plan for state site guidelines, including a cost point.
