

## **2013 VHSL girls golf open zone qualifiers - Update (10/02/13)**

The zone qualifiers for this year are as follows:

**Northern Zone** – Tuesday, October 22 – Laurel Hill Golf Course (Lorton); First Tee Time 12:00pm – Hosted by Aaron Helmick - West Potomac High School. Registration Deadline October 18.

**Western Zone** – Hosted by Travis Cantrell – Floyd County High School; other information TBD.

**Far West Zone** – Tuesday October 22 – Cedar Hill Country Club (Jonesville) – hosted by Ray Robbins – Lee High School. Practice Round on Oct. 21. Registration Deadline October 18.

**Northwest Zone** - comprised of member schools between the Roanoke Metro area to the Charlottesville-Lynchburg Metro areas, the Valley and Northern schools not included in the Northern Region. **Site still needed.**

**Central Zone** – Tuesday, October 22 – Dogwood Trace Golf Course (Petersburg) – hosted by William Lawson – Petersburg High School. Registration Deadline October 18.

**Eastern Zone** – Hosted by Hollie Godfrey – First Colonial High School; other information TBD.

**Southern Section** – Monday, October 21 – Greens Folly Golf Course (South Boston); First Tee Time 10:00am – Hosted by Allen Lawter - Halifax High School; Practice Round on Oct. 20 after 1pm (free round; cart extra). **Please submit registrations to the director of your zone qualifier as soon as possible.**

The girls' zone qualifiers will be conducted on the Monday, Tuesday or Wednesday (**October 21, 22 or 23 for 2013**) between the VHSL Boys Championship Tournament (October 14 and 15) and the VHSL State Girls Open Championship (October 28 and 29) at Jefferson Lakeside Country Club in Richmond, VA

The Girls State Open Qualifying process is as follows:

The number of golfers advancing to the State VHSL Girls Open will be **20%** from each of the zone qualifiers.

Exemptions will be offered to any girl who participates in her Region golf tournament **and finishes among the top 15 individual scorers.**

Girls will be permitted to play on their boys golf teams until such time as a viable stand-alone program for girls exists. **Girls who qualify as individuals from regional competition to state competition must choose whether they intend to participate in the individual portion of the Boys State Championship event or in the Girls Open Championship.**
