



## **SOCCER REGULAR SEASON TIE-BREAKING PROCEDURES**

When the score of a regular season match is tied at the end of a regulation time, the referee shall instruct both teams to return to their respective team boxes. There will be five minutes during which both teams may confer with their coaches and the head referee will instruct teams as to proper procedures below.

1. There shall be two five-minute overtime periods.
  - a. A coin toss shall be held as in Rule 5-2-2(d-3).
  - b. At the end of the first five-minute overtime period, teams shall change ends and begin play immediately.
  
2. If a tie still exists after two five-minute overtime periods, the match shall be recorded as a tie.
