If there are going to be Conferences, what about basing them within the present districts and taking them sport by sport. Or what if each present "region" came up with a solution and submitted it to solve these issues. I understand for football the "size" of school matters. But does it really matter for Field Hockey?

It is unfair to change a school's original placement just because another school from a lower classification needs to be moved up. The domino effect should not occur.
