

# VHSL 2009 Writing/Photography/Design Journalism Contest Results

A total of 999 examples of outstanding scholastic journalism – writing, photography and design – are recognized in VHSL’s 2009 competition for magazine, newspaper and yearbook journalists. They were selected from entries submitted by 59 different student publications. Judging was based first on meeting standards for outstanding journalism, then top entries were ranked on the basis of quality in each category by VHSL group.

Fewer awards in some categories reflect low participation in those categories.

Certificates of achievement were mailed to all winners in October.
